Health & Safety Policy Statement

Company Responsibilities

4. Review and develop these standards continuously. Revise them accordingly when changes in legislation, industry practice or technology occur

We are committed to consult with employees on health, safety and welfare issues by:

1. Ensuring that our employees are trained to understand and carry out their responsibilities. This will involve, but will not be limited to, selection, training, re-training and continuous assessment of employee performance
2. Continually monitoring this policy by auditing and reviewing its effectiveness in the workplace

Legal Obligations

We recognise the legal obligations placed on us by the Health & safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and other Statutory Legislation as may be applicable to our undertaking.

Our Health and Safety documentation and records will be made freely accessible to employees, contractors, customers and members of the public who may be affected by our operations.
